

# Community Service Activities

As a member of our faith, community service is part of belonging to the community. As young adults it is a good habit to have; giving back to the community is a worthwhile investment of time.

All Confirmation candidates are required to do community service. Ten activities will be required to be done by **March 31, 2015**. Please take some time and plan what you are going to do.

A community service activity is something which you participate in for the good of others without any payment. If you belong to a scouting group, honor society, or any other organization that does community service you can also use it for Confirmation. An activity is considered an event: for example, if you are participating in a car wash, bake sale, or beach cleanup that is one activity. If you do ongoing service such as Altar serving, coaching, or tutoring, that would be considered one event. There are many opportunities through school, neighbors, sports, and even the Church. Keep an open mind and heart!
