



# **Scripture Reflection**

#### 14th Sunday In Ordinary Time



Jesus, gentle and humble of heart, came to bring peace to all people. Each and every one of us are called to live in His Spirit, to be gracious,

merciful and compassionate to all, not just to those who can help us in return. St. Paul knew of only one authentic humanity: Jesus. He exhorted the Romans to reject that ego seeking, self-gratifying reality known as the flesh and to adopt that life-giving, othersoriented reality known as the Spirit. St. Paul calls that Spirit not only the Spirit of God but also the Spirit of Christ. To be led by the Spirit is to be really alive. To live according to the flesh is to be dead. To have the Spirit is to have Jesus. Accept no substitutes, only Jesus will do. Jesus was considered a total paradox. He avoided titles because of their implications. He controlled no one and wanted to avoid any sense of earthly power. Acceptance of Jesus was personal, free and liberating. He attracted people by the example of His life and teaching. That lesson has proved difficult for us and often times we have forgotten it. Christ leaves us no doubt that humility is vital in our search for God. It is not a prized quality in our society where success is measured on arrogance, ambition and ruthlessness and self-aggrandizement. The humble person does not have to complicate matters by projecting such a false self-image or deceive himself with the trappings of grandeur. He or she realizes that without God they are nothing. If we are lacking in humility we are robbed of that inner peace which comes from putting our life in the hands of God. Humility enables us to let go of self and make space for God in whom we find our strength. Christ meets each and every one of us at our own level.
