Annual Mission Appeal Collection

This weekend, July 15th and 16th, Brother Victor Stanislaus, CMSF will be visiting our parish to speak about the Franciscan Missionary Brothers' work in India and conduct a mission appeal. The Franciscan Missionary Brothers are a group of religious Brothers founded in India in 1901 by Brother Hermann Paulus Moritz, to work in places where Catholics are a minority. The Brothers have their missions in the poorest parts of the world: India, Sri Lanka, Paraguay, Bolivia, Ghana and Kenya. The main task of the missionaries continues to be the proclamation of the Gospel and the establishment of viable Catholic communities. The Brothers primarily work among the non-Christians preaching the Gospel and bringing them to the Catholic fold. Other ministries include education, children's homes and orphanages, primary health care centers, providing potable water, and working with rural women for their empowerment. They also minister to people with leprosy and the victims of the AIDS epidemic. God Bless you for your prayers and financial assistance to help them to carry on these ministries. Scripture Reflection

15th Sunday In Ordinary Time



The seed that falls on good ground will yield a fruitful harvest. May the soil of our hearts be receptive to the Word and carry it out

through the presence of the Spirit. Each and every one of us who share in Eucharist confess that the path, the rocks and the thorns of the passion and death of Jesus are transformed into the abundant harvest of the resurrection. The readings for today give us a clear call, we all must nourish and cultivate a life of prayer, ongoing formation and education in the faith and living out our belief in service of others. Jesus compares the Word of God, which is intended to produce fruit in our lives, to seed sowed in the earth by the farmer. At baptism the delicate and demanding seed of the Word of God is first planted in our hearts. If it doesn't get our wholehearted attention by finding a home in our lives, it withers and dies. Often when the Lord comes knocking on our door we fail to make Him welcome because we are so preoccupied with the meaningless pursuits of the moment. To be a cultivator of goodness we have to dig deep within ourselves. God does not want part-time or halfhearted followers. His Word never blossoms alongside greed, arrogance, self-aggrandizement, snobbishness or in special elite groups and the love of the easy life. Growth in the life of Christ is not always a smooth, gradual and straightforward process. The different types of soil can well be the varied response we make to His Word. When we meet with setbacks and disappointments, obstacles may stack up against our good intentions and weaken our firm resolve. Moments like this call for deep faith. No matter what the situation, we have to struggle to believe. The Word of God has an immense and mysterious power to change us. The hard thorny path that our lives may be currently experiencing could be Christ's way of calling us back to a deeper union with him. Experience tells us we have to work for anything that is worth having. Reaping the rich harvest of God's goodness depends on our openness to receive His Word. So often, when God is sowing the seed of His love around us we are cold, offhand and too proud to allow ourselves to be won over. However, there is good soil in every human heart and given time and effort and a considerable degree of pain, the Spirit of the living God will put down deep roots in our lives, assuring us of eternal salvation.

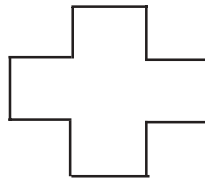
